Medical Care

We believe that healthy people are the foundation of a prosperous nation!

KCM operates two modern hospitals and 14 satellite clinics in Chililabombwe and Chingola. These provide health services to employees and their families for free, as well as communities, at a reasonable fee.

The health institutions provide routine and specialized health services, which include:

HIV/AIDS – Free ARVs to over 3,000 people; 500 of which receive nutritional supplements under the care of over 200 counselors and peer educators.

Rollback Malaria – the Indoor Residue Spraying (IRS) campaign has reduced malaria incidences from over 100/1,000 in 2000 to 68/1,000 at present. More than 40,000 households are covered annually.

KCM has also provided diabetic eye care to over 2,000 diabetic patients in 6 districts of the Copperbelt region. We have also provided 2,500 eye glasses.



Education

We believe education is the cornerstone of sustainable development

KCM Trust Schools – We operate Secondary and Primary Trust Schools with around 2,400 pupils in Chingola and Chililabombwe, offering education from pre-grade to A-levels.

Scholarships – Over 600 Zambians have received KCM scholarships for university study at home and abroad in mining fields and other disciplines since 2010. KCM also runs the Kitwe Trades School which trains around 150 artisans each year.

Early Childhood Education – Pre-grade education is provided to 320 children at two KCM-funded modern early childhood education centres.

Computer Literacy – More than 9,000 pupils in 19 government-run schools have access to PCs provided by KCM.

Infrastructure Development – KCM has provided clean drinking water facilities in 13 public schools and constructed new classroom blocks at 4 schools. Our support to the education sector impacts over 42,000 children. In 2017, KCM installed 5 solar-powered boreholes providing clean water in peri-urban areas of chingola.

Environmental Awareness - Nearly 90,000 trees, including citrus trees have been planted in communities and government-run schools under the KCM "Go Green" environmental support programmes. More recently, 2,000 elite Pongamia Pinnata trees were planted on a 4-hectare overburden site at Tailings dump number 2 in Chingola to revegetate the land and enhance soil fertility.





Sustainable Livelihoods

Integrated Community Development Programmes

Our flagship sustainable livelihoods project is the 5-year cattle restocking programme launched in 2012. About 900 cattle have been given to 2,700 small scale farmers in three districts, impacting more than 14,000 people.
